### **BRAZZAVILLE DECLARATION**

We, the Ministerial Council of APPO, hereby declare our commitment to the following principles and objectives:

**Noting** the theme of this conference, "Improving the Local Supply of Quality Goods and Services: A Strategic Lever for Maximizing African Participation in the Oil and Gas Industry".

**Recognizing** the importance of Local Content as a strategic lever for maximizing African participation in the Oil & Gas industry,

**Committed** to strengthening collaboration and partnerships among African nations, especially APPO Member Countries, international partners, and industry stakeholders to achieve shared goals,

#### We hereby make the following declaration:

- (1) **Develop** mechanism for measuring Local Content achievements in Member Countries
- (2) **Promote** the development and implementation of effective Local Content Policies and Strategies in Africa's O&G industry especially across APPO Member Countries.
- (3) Enhance the capacity of African suppliers to provide quality goods and services to the O&G industry, ensuring their competitiveness and sustainability.
- (4) Facilitate access to funding, technology, and expertise for local businesses, fostering innovation and entrepreneurship.
- (5) Create opportunities for skills development and knowledge transfer, building a competent African workforce and businesses for the O&G Sector.
- (6) Encourage collaboration among international and local companies, promoting joint ventures and partnerships for mutual benefits.
- (7) Support the harmonization of Local Content Requirements and Regulations across the African Continent.
- (8) Foster collaborative Research, Development and Innovation initiatives that address the specific needs and challenges facing the African O&G industry.
- (9) Encourage Public/Private Partnerships among entrepreneurs to strengthen capacity and quality of goods and services supplied to the industry.
- (10) Monitor progress and share best practices in Local Content Development, Social and Emvironmental Responsibilty.



This Declaration serves as a **call to action for all stakeholders** to work together in a spirit of cooperation and collective respect to achieve the shared vision of a thriving African Oil and Gas industry that benefits the people of the Continent.
